OSHA's Hazard Communication Standard (HCS) requires a list of hazardous chemicals in the workplace as part of an employer's written HazCom program. This list serves as an chemical inventory for which an MSDS must be maintained. The hazardous nature of the chemical and the potential for exposure are the factors which determine whether a chemical is covered. As new chemicals are purchased, the inventory list is to be updated. [OSHA Guidelines for Employer Compliance (Advisory) 1910.1200 Appendix E].

- Report chemical quantities by product and location
